The **Florida Nature Coast Bike Fest, Inc.** is a Florida 501c-3 Non-Profit corporation founded in 2020 originally as the **Hernando County Bike Fest, Inc.**, in order to continue the **"Brooksville Bike Rally"**.

As a component of the **Hernando County Growers Association, Inc.**, the monthly **Brooksville Bike Rally** attracted thousands of visitors to Hernando County and provided a funding source for the **Growers Association's** food insecurity programs such as the Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program and Fresh Access Bucks SNAP dollar matching program.

The inaugural event was held March 25, 2018, on Main Street in front of the Hernando County Courthouse and attracted approximately 3,500 visitors with 43 vendors.

The **First Annual Three-Day Hernando County Bike Fest** was held March 18-20, 2022, with over 125 vendors and approximately 14,000 attendees. Beginning in March 2023, the event will be known as the "**Florida Nature Coast Bike Fest**".

We are 100% volunteer operated and have provided support to over twenty separate charitable causes with significant local impact in Hernando County.



# To meet the hunger needs of school children in our community.

Since 2009, **Operation HeartF.E.L.T.** has been providing nutritious meals to children suffering from food insecurity through their backpack program. **Operation HeartF.E.L.T.** services on average about 250 students per week who have been identified by the schools as needing their help. **HeartF.E.L.T.** children receive a backpack every Friday or before a holiday break containing six meals for the weekend. During holiday breaks, the bags are adjusted accordingly. Their volunteers are responsible for shopping for food, stocking their warehouse shelves, packing the backpacks and delivering to and picking up the backpacks from schools. The bags are not identifiable to anyone other than the child, with no reference to the contents. Their volunteers work closely with principals and guidance counselors to ensure that students' names and personal information remain confidential. **Operation HeartF.E.L.T. Foundation** provides over **300,000 meals** annually to children during the school year.

## Name Change

Moving into 2023, we recognize that many of our sponsors and partners have a significant presence throughout the west central region of Florida. In support of their participation and the impact it has on the region as a whole, we are pleased to announce the **Florida Nature Coast Bike Fest**, formerly known as the **Hernando County Bike Fest**.

In 1991, the "Nature Coast" was designated by Florida Tourism as a region encompassing Wakulla, Jefferson, Taylor, Dixie, Levy, Citrus, Hernando, and Pasco counties.

We believe that the continued growth and success of the "Florida Nature Coast Bike Fest" will generate opportunity and recognition for our partners all along the west central Gulf coast as well as create new opportunities for it to contribute to charitable causes impacting the region.

Additionally, this expansion will create opportunities for more partners and sponsors to participate and support motorcycle culture and tourism throughout the region.








